



Need help to access Government wage subsidies?



Joblife Employment can help businesses access Government funding when they employ someone through our disability employment service.

The Wage Subsidy Scheme and the Restart program offer financial incentives to encourage employers to provide opportunities to eligible job seekers eager to demonstrate their suitability for ongoing employment.

Is your business eligible?

To qualify for the Wage Subsidy Scheme or Restart you must:

- ✓ have an Australian Business Number
- ✓ have not previously received a wage subsidy for the same job
- ✓ have not recently retrenched or reduced the number of workers or be proposing to do so
- ✓ be not receiving another government wage subsidy for the same worker or position



Wage Subsidy Scheme

Businesses can receive a financial incentive of up to \$1,650 (inclusive of GST) when they employ a person registered with our service. The job must be for at least eight hours per week for a period of 13 weeks.

Restart

A Restart wage subsidy is a financial incentive of up to \$10,000 (GST inclusive) that is available to qualifying businesses that employ eligible participants who are 50 years of age or older.

Payments are available over a six-month period and employers can negotiate how often they receive payment.

Wage Subsidy Case Study

Maria is a 25 year old woman who has completed a Certificate III in Hospitality and has her RSA and RSG certificates.

She is fluent in both Greek and English. Maria has Multiple Sclerosis which she manages through medication and other treatments.

She is punctual, polite, reliable and a fast learner.

Employers may also be eligible to receive a 'kickstart' payment of up to 40 percent of the total wage subsidy after four weeks of a job starting.

Payments may include:

- \$4,000.00 after 4 weeks of employment
- \$3,000.00 after 13 weeks of employment
- \$3,000.00 after 26 weeks of employment

for a total of \$10,000 altogether.

Restart Case Study

Tony is a 52-year-old man who suffered a back injury playing rugby league in 2016.

His injury meant that he could no longer work as a builder and he needed to find work which did not involve heavy lifting or standing for long periods.

He went back to TAFE and completed studies in IT. He has a strong work ethic and would make a dedicated and enthusiastic worker.

An employer would receive \$10,000 over six months if they employed Tony under the Restart Program.
